The CYPN Workgroup supports twelve local Young Professional Network chapters across the state and six at large members. Each YPN Chapter aims to strengthen the younger generation of professionals by encouraging growth and creating connections. This is achieved through monthly meetings, events, and professional development opportunities.

The CYPN workgroup is responsible for connecting YPN Chairs from each of the twelve chapters across Colorado. They do this each month via meetings to offer support/feedback and to brainstorm different ways the YPN chapters can achieve their goal of strengthening the younger generation in their networks.

2026 Key Endeavors

Member Engagement:

The CYPN Gus Williams Award has been expanded to accept applicants from all REALTOR® members, regardless of whether they belong to a local association that has a YPN. The award application will open June 8 – June 23. We are looking forward to connecting with and honoring our young professional REALTOR® members from across the State.

Events:

We had a very successful CYPN reception last night. We sold about 65 tickets and had a great evening networking with fellow YPN members at the Aviator Bar. We will be hosting our second Capitol Tour for all YPN members in August and our second educational hybrid event in Vail at the end of September.

Network Support:

The advisory group is working to assemble a YPN toolkit, which will help new networks understand the process to become established, while also supporting our current networks. In addition, CYPN has two grants – one \$500 grant for new networks, and one \$500 grant for revitalized networks. The advisory group will continue to find ways to support our local networks and would like to help more local associations start their own YPN Chapters.
